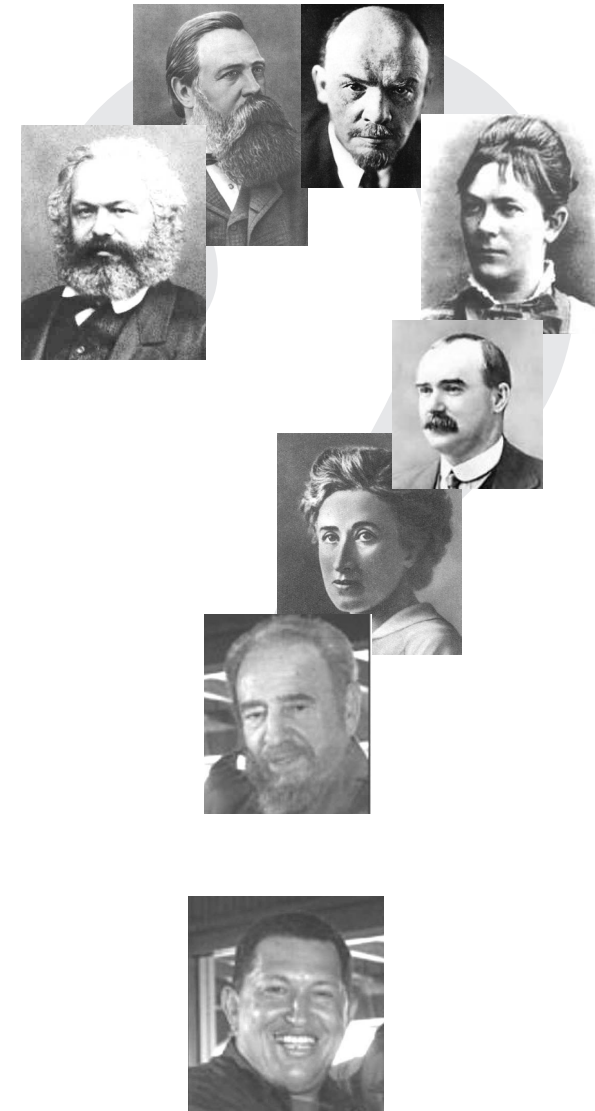
“The philosophers have only interpreted the world, in various ways; the point is to change it.”—Karl Marx
